Dear Friends

I hope that you have been able to 'Sabbath' for a time over the summer. Balancing what we do with our time is so important for every facet of our health and being able to do what God is asking us to. Rather than falling in a heap after flogging ourselves with all the things, it's far better to maintain a rhythm of working from our resting place in God. That's what Sabbath is about!

It's about entering into a place of relying on God for everything we need [!]

God knows we need a whole 24 hours of sleep, hanging out with him and his people, and celebrating together. He also knows we need a period of rest every day. Before electricity was invented people mainly worked during hours of daylight.

The night time is a gift from God to rest from all our labours. To talk around the fire. To laugh and cry and pray. To reflect. To tell God about our day and listen to what He has to say. I love the thought of being able to walk with God in the cool of the evening in the garden. I love being able to pray and converse with God's people also. These times enrich my soul and encourage me and guide me in what God wants me to do.

To mature as the people of God in 2024 together - we each need to be intentional in how we establish rhythms of worship, of becoming community and of partnering with Jesus in making new disciples. If we don't attend to all three of these aspects of our lives we won't grow as a individuals or as a church. This month we will be focussing on how we do this. As relational beings we all need to feel we belong in order to flourish in our community. This is why Jesus said love God with all that you are and love others as you love yourself. Please pray this month asking God to guide you in finding others with whom you can intentionally journey in figuring this out together.
